We are looking for an internationally renowned scientist with an innovative research program in the area of sustainable crop production. A research focus should be related to approaches for increasing the resource efficiency in agricultural crop stands. Experience in conducting field trials is welcome. We expect teaching activities in the area of agricultural crop production in the B.Sc. and M.Sc. study programs of the Faculty of Agriculture.

The successful candidate is expected to use and extend the research networks at the Faculty of Agriculture, addressing e. g. soil-root interactions, crop responses to abiotic and biotic stress, yield formation, high throughput phenotyping, and precision farming. The acquisition of extramural funding and the coordination of collaborative research projects are expected.

Candidates have to comply with the general prerequisites according to § 36 of the University law (Hochschulgesetz) of the federal state of Northrhine-Westphalia.
